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Section 1 Description

Membership to the Tit & Pecker is highly coveted, granting privileged access to its exclusive events, tastings, and private gatherings. It's a sanctuary where members can unwind, socialise, and forge lasting connections in the tranquil beauty of rural Oxfordshire.

Section 2 Ground Rules

Subsection A - Respect and Courtesy:

- I. Members must treat fellow patrons, staff, and the establishment with respect and courtesy at all times.
- II. Discriminatory behaviour, harassment, or intimidation of any kind will not be tolerated.

Subsection B - Membership Card:

- I. Members must present their valid membership card upon entry and when making purchases at the bar.
- II. Sharing or lending membership cards to non-members is strictly prohibited.

Subsection C - Dress Code:

- I. The Tit & Pecker maintains a smart-casual dress code.
- II. Members are expected to dress appropriately, avoiding overly casual attire such as sportswear or beachwear.

Subsection D - Responsible Drinking:

- I. Enjoyment of alcoholic beverages is encouraged, but members are expected to consume alcohol responsibly.
- II. Intoxicated behaviour, excessive drinking, or attempting to serve alcohol to minors will result in immediate expulsion from the premises.

Subsection E - Confidentiality:

- I. What happens at the Tit & Pecker stays at the Tit & Pecker.
- II. Members must respect the privacy and confidentiality of fellow patrons and refrain from sharing sensitive information outside of the establishment.

Subsection F - No Smoking:

- I. In accordance with local regulations and to maintain a pleasant environment for all patrons, smoking is strictly prohibited inside the Tit & Pecker.
- II. Designated outdoor smoking areas are available for those who wish to smoke.

Subsection G - Cleanliness and Hygiene:

- I. Members are expected to maintain cleanliness and hygiene standards while inside the establishment.
- II. Littering, vandalism, or damage to property will not be tolerated.

Subsection H - Compliance with Laws:

- I. Members must adhere to all local laws and regulations while on the premises of the Tit & Pecker, including those related to alcohol consumption, noise levels, and public behaviour.

Subsection I - Management Discretion:

- I. The management reserves the right to refuse entry or service to any member who violates these ground rules or engages in behaviour deemed inappropriate or disruptive to the ambiance of the establishment.

Subsection J - Drug Policy:

- I. The possession, use, or distribution of illegal substances within the premises is strictly prohibited. Any individual found violating this policy will be subject to immediate expulsion from the club and may face legal consequences.
- II. We encourage members to report any suspicious activity to club management promptly.

Subsection K - Music:

- I. Music must always be added to the Spotify™ queue, no Spotify™, no luck.
- II. Breaking the queue will result in public shaming until your current beverage is consumed.

Subsection L - Cats:

- I. Cats are to remain inside the club at all times, any member caught releasing the a cat will not return until the cat has returned

Subsection A - Member List:

Subsection B - Initiation Process:

1. In order to begin the initiation process, the following must occur:
 1. Form TP-063 must be completed and handed into the club with colour passport style photo attached.
 2. Owners and Bar Manager are to deliberate on candidate suitability.
 3. Probationary membership is granted after candidate is deemed suitable, this lasts for 4 weeks during which the members hold the right to revoke membership for any reason.

Subsection C - New Members:

1. On first visit to the club new members must bring:
 1. One bottle of a spirit of their choice.
 2. Legally recognised identification document.
 3. Bill/Invoice with name and address.
 4. Anything else at the discretion of the Owners/Bar Manager.
2. Failure to bring any of the above could result in rejection of entry.

Section 4 Fire Safety Procedure

Subsection A - Prevention Measures:

- I. Regular Inspections: The Tit & Pecker conducts regular inspections of its premises to identify and rectify potential fire hazards. This includes checking electrical systems, heating equipment, and kitchen appliances.
- II. Maintenance: All fire safety equipment, including fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, and emergency lighting, is regularly maintained and tested according to local regulations.
- III. Clear Exits: Clear and unobstructed emergency exits are clearly marked and maintained at all times to ensure swift evacuation in case of fire.
- IV. Smoking Policy: Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the Tit & Pecker premises. Designated outdoor smoking areas are provided with appropriate ashtrays and fireproof containers

Subsection B - Emergency Response Plan:

- I. Alerting Authorities: In the event of a fire, staff members are trained to immediately alert the fire department by calling the emergency services number (e.g., 999) and providing detailed information about the location and nature of the fire.
- II. Evacuation Procedure: Upon discovering a fire or upon hearing the fire alarm, patrons and staff must evacuate the building immediately using the nearest unobstructed emergency exit. Staff members are assigned specific roles to assist patrons during evacuation.

- III. Assembly Point: A designated assembly point is located a safe distance away from the building where patrons and staff must gather after evacuating. Roll call is conducted to ensure all individuals have safely evacuated the premises.
- IV. Assistance for Patrons: Staff members are trained to assist patrons with disabilities or mobility impairments during evacuation, providing guidance and support as necessary.

Subsection C - Training and Awareness:

- I. Staff Training: All staff members receive comprehensive training in fire safety procedures, including fire prevention, evacuation protocols, and the proper use of fire extinguishers.
- II. Regular Drills: Fire evacuation drills are conducted periodically to ensure that all staff members and patrons are familiar with emergency procedures and evacuation routes.
- III. Communication: Information regarding fire safety procedures, evacuation routes, and emergency contact numbers is prominently displayed throughout the Tit & Pecker premises for easy reference.

Subsection D - Review and Update:

- I. Regular Review: The Tit & Pecker's fire safety procedures are regularly reviewed and updated to incorporate any changes in regulations, building layout, or operational practices.
- II. Feedback and Improvement: Feedback from staff members and patrons regarding fire safety procedures is welcomed and used to continually improve and enhance the effectiveness of the emergency response plan.

Section 5 Drinking Rules

Subsection A - Wise Wizard

- I. Drinks that are consumed from a can (including decanted) "Wise Wizard" is instigated. Cans are to be taped together creating an increasingly long staff.
- II. Revision 1a - Drinks that are processed while decanting (i.e. NitroSurge Guinness™) are not included.

Subsection B - To The Line

- I. Members have the option to call a line on their pint glass where their first sip will come to. If they hit the aforementioned line, everyone else in the Tit & Pecker has to take a drink.

Subsection C - Empty Bottle

- I. If a member empties any bottle of the clubs spirt, said member is then responsible for its replacement.

Section 6 Drinking Games

Subsection A - Beer Pong

- I. Team Structure: Each game consists of two teams, each comprising two players. The objective is to successfully land a ball into the opposing team's cups.
- II. Scoring: When a cup is hit, it must be consumed after both balls have been thrown. Balls must be promptly removed from the cups once they've landed. The team that eliminates all of the opposing team's cups first is declared the winner.
- III. Starting Team: The starting team is determined by a simple eye-to-eye contest. One member from each team makes eye contact with the opposing team member, and both simultaneously attempt to hit a cup. The team that scores first gains the advantage of starting the round.
- IV. Throwing Regulations: Players must ensure that their wrist remains behind the edge of the table while throwing.
- V. "Balls Back": If a player successfully lands a shot, they are granted the opportunity to take another turn, known as "balls back."
- VI. "Rearrange": During the game, players can request that the opposing team readjust their cups if they're not positioned correctly. This option, known as "Rearrange," is only applicable when there are 6, 4, 3, or 2 cups remaining for the requesting team.
- VII. Bounce Shots: Shots that bounce off the table and into a cup count as two cups.
- VIII. "Bomb": If both players on opposing teams hit the same cup simultaneously, all cups that are in contact with the hit cup are removed from play.
- IX. "Redemption": When only one cup remains, the opposing team is granted a redemption shot. If they successfully land the shot, the game continues, and the last cup is not removed.

Subsection B - Werewolf

- I. Game Steps
 - a) Deal out cards to players – roles are kept a secret!
 - b) You spend the night in new village, and everyone closes their eyes. During that night, the following happens:
 1. Cupid picks two lovers, the two lovers are told who they are in love with (first night only)
 2. The harlot chooses where they will stay for the night.
 3. The seer chooses someone to determine if they are a werewolf.
 4. The werewolves pick their victim.
 5. The witch can choose to: save the victim or kill someone else (each of these are once per game).

- c) The village wakes up to find the dead (or not) and discuss what has happened. They must vote to hang someone before the days end.
 - i. The role of the hanged person is not disclosed by the game-master, the player can do as they wish before they die.
- d) Repeat steps 2 and 3 until all werewolves or villagers are dead.

II. Character Roles

	Villager	No special abilities. Your aim is to kill all the werewolves.
	Werewolf	As a group, you can kill one person each night. Your aim is to kill all villagers.
	The Witch	You have two potions, one will save a murder victim, the other will kill any player. You can use both once, but not on the same night. You can use either on yourself. Your aim is to kill all the werewolves.
	The Seer	Each night, the seer can choose one person and learn if they are a werewolf. Your aim is to kill all the werewolves.
	Cupid	You are a villager, but on the first night, you choose two players to become lovers.
	The Lovers	You are two players bound by love, if one dies, the other will die of grief. The role of lover is in addition to the card you were dealt (i.e. a werewolf and a villager can become lovers). The lovers win if they are the only survivors at the end of the game.
	The Traitor	You have no special powers and look exactly like a villager. However, you hate the village and all it stands for. You win if the werewolves win, even if you die in the process. If all werewolves die before the end of the game, you become a werewolf.
	The Harlot	You are a villager. Each night you can choose to stay in your own bed, or someone else's. If you are chosen as the victim, but are in another's bed, you survive. However, you will die if you are in the bed of a werewolf, or a werewolf victim. You win with the villagers.
	The Fool	You are a villager... but you have issues. You want to be hanged as a werewolf. I have no idea why, but if you succeed in this endeavour, you win.

Section 7 Privacy

Subsection A - Privacy Policy

1. The EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") came into force across the European Union on 25th May 2018 and brings with it the most significant changes to data protection law

in two decades. Based on privacy by design and taking a risk-based approach, the GDPR has been designed to meet the requirements of the digital age.

- ii. The 21st Century brings with it broader use of technology, new definitions of what constitutes personal data, and a vast increase in cross-border processing. The new Regulation aims to standardise data protection laws and processing across the EU; affording individuals stronger, more consistent rights to access and control their personal information.
- iii. The Tit & Pecker Members Club is committed to ensuring the security and protection of the personal information that we process, and to provide a compliant and consistent approach to data protection. We have always had a robust and effective data protection program in place which complies with existing law and abides by the data protection principles.
